Rules regarding Mobile Phones, Smart Watches and other Electronic Devices

Dear Parents and Students,

Please refer to the CBSE Circular NO. CBSE/AFF/CIRCULARS/2009, dated 29/07/2009 Circular No.02

- Students are not allowed to wear smart watches to School.
- Students are not allowed to bring any other electronic gadget like earphone, headphone, iPod, Pen drive etc.
- School will not be responsible for any loss or damage to the mobile phones or any other electronic device.
- If a student is found in possession of a mobile phone or any other electronic device or any other material which is not related to academics and brought without Permission of school authorities it will be confiscated for the entire, academic year and a fine of Rs. 500/- would be received.
- In case if students are travelling home on their own and parents want them to carry phone. It is mandatory for parents to come to school with an application for the same after which child would be allowed to carry a GSN mobile which will have to be deposited at the reception immediately after child's arrived in school.
- At no cost mobile is allowed inside school premises.

- Please remember that messages or images etc. that are added to the class groups or official groups chat, like any social media, are in the public domain, so we request you to be mindful of what you post.
