Environment can be natural or manmade. A natural environment composed of land, air, water and plants and animals. Natural environment can be biotic or abiotic means living and non-living for eg. Plants and land respectively. Land is Lithosphere which is composed of solid crust or hard upper layer of earth. It is composed of rocks and soil which is important for various activities. Water is Hydrosphere or domain of water bodies on the earth like river, lakes ponds, seas and oceans. Atmosphere is blanket of air around us. It gives us oxygen and also protect us from UV rays. Biosphere is narrow zone where land ,air and water interact to make life possible. The system formed by interaction of organisms with each other and with its physical and chemical factors is called an Ecosystems.
