Types of Sentences- Four

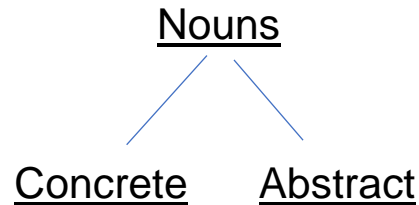
- ➔ All statements are **declarative sentences**.
- ➔ When we request or command, it is **imperative sentence**.
- ➔ When we ask question, it is **interrogative sentence**.
- ➔ All exclamations are **exclamatory sentences**.

Subject and Predicate

- ➔ A sentence is divided into two parts- subject and predicate.
- ➔ **Subject** tells us what the sentence is about.
- ➔ **Predicate** tells us about the subject.

- ➔ Grandpa was a forest officer.
- ➔ Elephants are intelligent creatures.
- ➔ Elephant menace means that elephants were in the rice fields and eating up the crops.
- ➔ An old granary was near the village.

- ➔ Abstract nouns- which we cannot see or touch like qualities, actions or conditions.
