Types of Sentences- Four


- → All statements are **declarative sentences**.
- → When we request or command, it is **imperative sentence**.
- → When we ask question, it is **interrogative sentence**.
- → All exclamations are **exclamatory sentences**.

Subject and Predicate

- → A sentence is divided into two parts- subject and predicate.
- → Subject tells us what the sentence is about.
- → Predicate tells us about the subject.
